I have given regularly clinical presentation of patients during ward rounds. I have developed and understanding of the clinical management of the clinically ill patients and I have acquired skills in the insertion and interpretation of invasive monitoring, i.e insertion of central venous catheters and artherial catheters. I also studied haemodinamic monitoring and new aspects thereof such as the C.O.L.D. system and gastric tonometry.

I have collaborated in published scientific research in this area.

I started to gain experience under Consultant supervision in Obstetric analgesia and anaesthesia . I couldn't perform regional anaesthesia for labour or for caesarean section because I had not a proper insurance for this kind of specialty.

At Charing Cross Hospital I improved my experience under the supervision of Dr. Patric Salt Anaesthetist Consultant for Neurosurgical, Vascular, ENT, Orthopedic, Day Unit, Plastic, General, Urology and Trauma Surgery. During this period I acquired more practise in invasive monitoring. I spent some time in intensive care units directed by Dr. M. Palazzo.I took part in all the teaching sessions that were held in both Hospitals.

During this period I had a locum job as anaesthetic SHO at Queen Mary's University Hospital Roehampton (29/7/96-6/8/96). In this Hospital I had a session list every day in General ,Orthopedic,Dental surgery.
